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In addition the Board have agreed to commit £50K across three years to Unltd to establish Social Enterprise in the Big Local Area.

The Detached Youth Project will be asked to support the costs of venue hire during the winter months from the grant and to carry out a needs and gap analysis of the area. By January 2019 they will submit a sustainability plan to the Partnership Board.

The £20K committed towards the development of a social enterprise/ community hub is in its infancy and will be flexible to support the Board members and residents in moving the idea into reality.
