Working with you to make White City Estate and Batman Close greener

Our partners from Groundwork London have been finding out what changes people want on the estate, to make it greener and improve it for the whole community. We've listened to what you told us and are now about to start work to make these improvements happen.

What is happening and where?

Improvements to Raised Planters

We will begin work on updating the raised planters outside of Abercrombie, Bathhurst, Bentick, Lawrence, Mackenzie, Carteret and Winthrop shortly - please see image overleaf which show which planters will be improved highlighted in orange. The works will involve repairing the brickwork and installing new planting

Works to Green Spaces

We will also begin work to the green spaces adjacent to Bathhurst, Carteret, Brisbane, Calvert, Mitchell, Denham, Davis and Evans House to install grass swales and basin. See plan overpage for location of the proposed works

When will the works take place?

Work will commence on site in **late August and be finished by the end of November** for both the raised planters and for the works to the green spaces. These features help reduce localised flooding, while adding to greenery and local biodiversity.

How will the work affect me?

We always employ considerate contractors, who we urge to avoid excessive noise and disruption. However, there may be times during the day when construction noises can be heard, some footpaths are obstructed, and some car parking spaces are blocked. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience.
