ROLE DESCRIPTION

Groundwork South is a company limited by guarantee and registered charity. We are made up of six teams working in the South of England. We are a member of the Federation of Groundwork Trusts that operates across the UK and who are committed to collective action to:

- Help 100,000 households overcome fuel poverty
- Improve 1,000 open spaces, involving and benefiting 1 million people

We work alongside local communities, public bodies, private companies and other voluntary sector organisations to support communities in need. Our projects are varied in type and size to achieve the following aims:
