
Project Description

Groundwork in partnership with Leeds Federated Housing Association worked to transform Woodville Square, a site which had fallen into disrepair and was in need of a radical facelift.

Groundwork carried out consultations with local residents and produced deatiled landscape proposals for the site.

Elements in the finished scheme include new paving, retaining walls, steel fencing, timber clad bin stores, and shrub planting.

A parking space, using permeable paving, was included for every property and the street was lined with Cherry trees to soften the hard landscaping and create a sence of place.
