

Groundwork East's privacy notice

Introduction

This Privacy Notice was last updated on 37/07/2019.

Groundwork East respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this privacy notice. We have notified our processing of personal data to, and are registered with, the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).

In this privacy notice references to "Groundwork", "Groundwork East", "us", "we", "our", "the Trust" are to Groundwork East.

We may update this privacy notice from time to time so you should check this page to see our most up to date policy.

This privacy notice tells you how we use information provided by you or collected about you when you use the website www.groundwork.org.uk/east and contact us on social media.

Please take some time to read this privacy notice before you use the website, engage with us on social media, or complete one of our surveys. It is a legally binding agreement and contains important information on your legal rights and obligations.

It explains the information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit our website, what we may use it for and whom we may give it to. It will also explain your rights towards your personal information and how we look after it while we have it.

What information do we collect?

In order to provide you with information about our services, we may collect personal information about you from our website, telephone conversations, emails, application forms and written communications.

The information we collect may vary based on what service we provide you. This may include information:

- by which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number or medical information ("personal information")
- that is about you but individually does not identify you, such as online user I.D, and/or
- about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our website and usage details.

We only collect information about you that we need to ensure you get the best service from us. We try to minimise what we do collect.

When someone visits our **website** we use **cookies** to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. This helps us to ensure that we can provide you with a good experience when you browse our website, it also allows us to improve our website and for our own market analysis.

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us.

Contacting us via **social media**: If you send us a private or direct message via social media, the message will not be stored outside of the applications. It will not be shared with any other organisations. Please read the applications terms and conditions and privacy notices.

How do we collect information about you?

We collect information:

- when you contact us for any reason

- when you set up an account on the website (for example to comment on blog posts)
- provided by you online, such as completing an online sign up form, or completing a survey
- when you interact with our advertising on social media
- automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses and information collected through **cookies**
- provided by you when you complete one of our surveys.

How do we use your information?

We use your information in various ways, such as to:

- provide you with information or services that you request from us
- send you marketing material, funding news or event invitations (you can opt out from this on the website)
- contact you about volunteering opportunities (if you signed up for this specifically)
- keeping our records accurate and up to date
- create statistical information, market research, analysis, customer profiling to improve our services
- comply with any legal obligations we may have
- meet any other purpose for which you provided your information

Legal grounds for processing your information

We will rely on the following legal bases under European Data Protection Legislation for processing your personal data:

- We have a legitimate interest in doing so. These legitimate interest will include our interests in carrying out our work and providing our services.
- Consent – in the case of marketing and medical information.

Data Security

We have implemented measures designed to secure your personal information from accidental loss and from unauthorised access, use, alteration and disclosure. All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers behind firewalls.

Your rights

The Data Protection Act 1998 and General Data Protection Regulation 2018 give you rights in respect of your personal information. We take all reasonable efforts to ensure we allow you to exercise those rights.

Your information rights

- European Data Protection Legislation gives you the right to access information held about you. You are entitled to be told by us whether we or someone else on our behalf is processing your personal information; what personal information we hold; details of the purposes for the processing of your personal information; and details of any third party with whom your personal information has been shared.
- You can access the personal information we hold on you by writing to us at: Groundwork East, Mill Green, Hatfield, Hertfordshire AL9 5PE. Requests for access will be responded to within one month of receiving the request.
- We will ask you to provide proof of identity before we show you your personal information – this is so we can prevent unauthorised access.
- You have the additional rights to request rectification and erasure of your personal data and to request restriction of, and to otherwise object to, our processing of your personal data and you can exercise these rights at any time by contacting us at: Groundwork East, Mill Green, Hatfield, Hertfordshire AL9 5PE.

- You are entitled to receive the personal data that you have provided to us, you can exercise this right by contacting us at: Groundwork East, Mill Green, Hatfield, Hertfordshire AL9 5PE.
