Preparation to work	One-to-one sessions: work towards your employment goals with our Employment Adviser
	Group sessions: meet experts in their field of work and learn how to get prepared for employment in the UK
Create	Create and Communicate: meet new people and practise your English in a friendly environment alongside some cultural / creative activities
	Women's Group: monthly women's only space to meet with, talk to, and support other women over a cup of tea
