


QUICK GUIDE ON HOW TO INSTALL DRAUGHT STRIPS


Controlled ventilation helps reduce condensation and damp, by letting fresh air in when needed. However, draughts are uncontrolled: they let in too much cold air and waste too much heat. To draught-proof your home you should block up unwanted gaps that let cold air in and warm air out.

You will need to wash and dry the window / door frame, using a sponge or cloth to ensure the surface is clean, so the draughts strips stick properly to the surface.



Measure the lengths that you need and cut the draught proofing strips to size.







In the unlikely event that the door/window does not shut properly after installing, remove the draught proofing strips.
