The post holder will also support the Principal Landscape Architect in developing and maintaining constructive working relationships with clients, contractors and other staff.

#### **KEY TASKS**

#### **Key Area: Landscape Design**

- Manage and undertake the production of landscape designs, from inception to completion, to client specification and within budget whilst ensuring that all schemes adhere to current design standards and are in keeping with the Trust's quality standards.
- Support the Principal landscape Architect to ensure that innovation, creativity and research are encouraged, supported and planned into the forward programme for the whole Landscape Team.
- Ensure time management of own which enable the production of quality, creative and yet achievable schemes which are fit for purpose and fit the agreed budget and time scales.

- Support the Principal Landscape Architect to undertake regular and rigorous quality checks of standards of presentation, design and materials presented across the whole of the Landscape Team.
- Ensure appropriate fee agreements are in place for every scheme.
- Ensure that all work produced conforms to the design templates and is correctly branded and fulfils the best marketing potential.

- Support the Principal Landscape Architect in managing the delivery the landscape programme.
- Review and refine systems and processes so appropriate for design, implementation and maintenance of high quality and sustainable landscape schemes.
- Monitor and manage resources so schemes are delivered within budgets utilising the Trust's business management system.
- Monitor and evaluate the success of schemes providing reports as required for the Trust's management, external bodies and clients.
- Work within and lead, as appropriate, multi-disciplinary project teams both internal and external to facilitate project delivery.
- Ensure on-going compliance with CDM regulations both in design practice and management of contractors.
