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- We work with schools to deliver a programme of both **academic and practical work**, which can result in learners gaining a NOCN Horticulture Level 1 **qualification**; a nationally recognised qualification for anyone interested in working in horticulture.
- Learners will **work on site** at school or in the community, developing **skills** that will help them with future career choices and improve their self esteem and personal development. For many learners, this is their first time achieving any kind of Certificate.
- Schools which have already used our provision report **positive outcomes** in terms of attendance, behaviour, attainment and interpersonal relationships.
- We can offer a **half-termly** programme, running for **six weeks**, which comprises of one full day per week for up to **six young people**. The course will run from 8.30am to 3.00pm, with 30 minutes for lunch, or adjusted to suit your school day.
- The work that your learners will undertake will positively impact on the school or community environment, as they will be **improving green spaces**, creating garden areas and even establishing edible planting.



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
