




Can you identify these four common UK tree species in your local park?



SILVER BIRCH

Bark is white and leaves are doubly toothed and triangular.




ENGLISH OAK

The leaves have short stalks and rounded 'lobes'.



COMMON ASH

'Compound' leaves with lots of leaflets, and smooth grey bark.



HORSE CHESTNUT

Distinctive 'compound' leaves, sometimes producing conkers.
