## WHY HOST A CSR DAY?

Hosting a CSR day can greatly impact your site and its local community. By choosing to offer your site with us, you can benefit from:

- No cost to your organisation (aside from some required resources)
- CSR volunteers enable you to address work that may be proving difficult to complete without extra help
- We will complete a site visit, talking through the tasks to be completed and complete a full risk assessment
- We will handle communication and planning with the organisation and volunteers, making it a simple process for you
- We will continue to offer your site until all tasks have been completed
- We will celebrate achievements on social media and, depending on how big the day is going to be, inform local media of the tasks taking place



# THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

When starting to think about what your site can offer, think about:

- The size of the group that your site can accommodate; most sites that we work with can accommodate 20-50 volunteers.
- The types of tasks you wish to be completed; what will benefit your site and its local community?
- Weather conditions; CSR days usually take place between March and October. They take a lot of planning and will go ahead in most weathers.
  - Volunteers can carry out the cutting back of overgrown areas and weeding when it's raining and colder whereas tasks such as painting and planting are more productive on sunnier and warmer days.
- What is 'the dream'? Tell us what your vision would look like if everything was possible. What would you like completing if you had the time and resource?



## **FIRST STEPS**

#### TASKS TO BE COMPLETED

As the majority of CSR volunteers are office based and not manual workers, we do not use power tools; tasks tend to be things that can be carried out with manual tools such as spades, forks, shears, paint brushes, etc. We will also adapt certain tasks to accommodate specific accessibility or other requirements of volunteers.

We typically won't carry out work higher than head height while standing on the ground. We will only consider work that needs to be done at higher levels when there is a safe way to do so.

Bigger is better! We usually have a team of 10-25+ volunteers in one day so we need to ensure there's plenty of tasks to do which cater to different abilities. What may look like a large task can sometimes not take very long when a team of 20 people begin working on it.



# YOU'RE IN SAFE HANDS

When you sign up to be a site host, or when an organisation visits you for a CSR day, you can rest assured that you are in safe hands.

All of our Groundwork staff are trained and experienced in carrying out the activities and are also First Aid trained and DBS checked. Groundwork Yorkshire hold full insurance to host CSR days on behalf of the site host.

Before any site is approved to host a CSR day, we complete a full risk assessment with photographs during our initial visit to ensure the site is safe for those working on it. We will then gather all the information needed to advertise your site as an opportunity.

# ON THE DAY

Once your site has been chosen, we will work with the organisation and volunteers to plan their day.

They are sent a document, telling them all about their planned day. This includes;

- A background of where they are going and why
- An agenda that sets out the tasks to be completed including timings
- Information on the Groundwork and site staff and dedicated first aiders
- Practical arrangements for parking and facilities
- Guidance on suitable clothing and footwear and anything else volunteers need to bring



#### A typical agenda looks like:

09:30	Volunteers arrive at site to meet Groundwork staff
09:45	Welcome, introductions and tool and site safety briefing
10:00	Tasks begin
11:00	Break
11:10	Tasks resume
12:00	Lunch
12:30	Return to site and brief about afternoon tasks
14:00	Break
14:10	Tasks resume
14:30	Site clear up
14:45	Participant feedback
15:00	Depart

### **FEEDBACK**

Keep sending us your ideas and tasks.

We regularly get new requests from organisations and are constantly looking for sites to help out on.

Be patient, your site may not be chosen immediately but we will continue to offer it until the work has been completed.

At the end of a CSR day we will ask for feedback on the tasks and overall experience and we welcome ideas and thoughts on what could help enhance future days.
