Wilder Streets

We currently have a gap in monitoring and understanding the impact and biodiversity value of the new Islington Greener Together highways sites built in 2023-2024. These range from parklets and pocket parks, to trees, planters and rain water gardens.

Wilder Streets, is a unique piece of community science. We hope to create a task force of Islington Greener Together Champions to carry out a **Wilder Streets Community Science** analysis of the new highways 'green' sites.

We need you!

It would be brilliant if a representative from every completed Greener Together Highways space would get involved, alongside anyone who can help out with auditing sites with no current Champions.

By taking part you will gain knowledge in the integral part you have played in increasing green space in Islington, and gain more understanding of the biodiversity you have enabled and opportunity for vital species to thrive. You will

also get a free kit to help you with your audits!

You can also obtain certification in our **Carbon Literacy Training**; an awareness of the Carbon Dioxide impacts of everyday activities, and the ability and motivation to reduce emissions on an individual, community and organisational basis.

Our Wilder Streets will begin with an in-person introductory **Community Science practical skills training** on **Wednesday 2nd April, 1:30pm - 4:30pm**at the Islington Ecology Centre, to learn the range of metrics monitored and the tools and methods used.

Grants of £50 - £100 are available to people who would like to improve an existing Forgotten Corner or Tree Pit in the Borough. The money can be used to improve an existing but neglected area or help towards developing a new one.

The Islington Gardeners plant sale will be held on <u>Sunday 27 April 2pm - 4pm</u> at **Olden Community Garden, Whistler Street N5 1NH.**

They are also looking for plant donations! These may be rooted cuttings, divisions, self-seeded plants, divided plants, plants you no longer need, or plants you have grown from seed.

Now is the time to start potting up plants so that they are well established by the sale date. Please mark pots clearly with the plant's name (either common name,

or botanical name or both). A brief description of the plant – annual or perennial, hardy or tender, height, spread, flowering time, colour of the flowers, also helps.

Please drop your plants off at Olden Garden on Saturday 26 April 6pm to 7pm or **Sunday morning, 27 April, 10am – 1pm** before the sale begins.

Please bring bags for plant purchases. Teas, scones and cakes will be available. Donations of cakes are also very welcome!
