Wansbeck Restoration for Climate Change (WRCC) will restore mixed habitats, showcasing how different landowners can come together to fight climate change, reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote carbon capture, bringing many benefits for nature and society.

WRCC will create and restore 6 priority habitats over 10 sites across 3 estates (Wallington Estate, Little Harle and Middleton North) totalling 144ha of direct habitat improvement in rural Northumberland.
