Our Supported Internship Programme provides structured work placements and tailored learning to help young people with additional needs gain employability skills and work experience.

Our key learning objectives

- Gain skills and a range of accredited qualifications
  - Undertake real workplace experience
  - Prepare for employment through mentoring and job coaching
  - Gain confidence
  - Learn to manage time effectively
  - Work as part of a team
  - Work experience in a real environment

Our interns will work alongside our team of dedicated tutors and our experienced inclusion worker to ensure they get the best out of their placement.

**Our Supported Internship runs for a year on a rolling programme; we do not require a September start, we can run a bespoke year of learning for each young person.**



During their year with us, interns will work for three days each week (during term time) in real workplace environments across the region, learning hard and soft landscaping skills as well as other horticulture based skills.



They will also spend one day per week with our dedicated tutor, working towards qualifications in Functional English and Maths, employability qualifications and their NOCN level 1 in Horticulture.
