We're looking for a confident and collaborative professional with a strong understanding of the construction sector and a passion for creating social value.

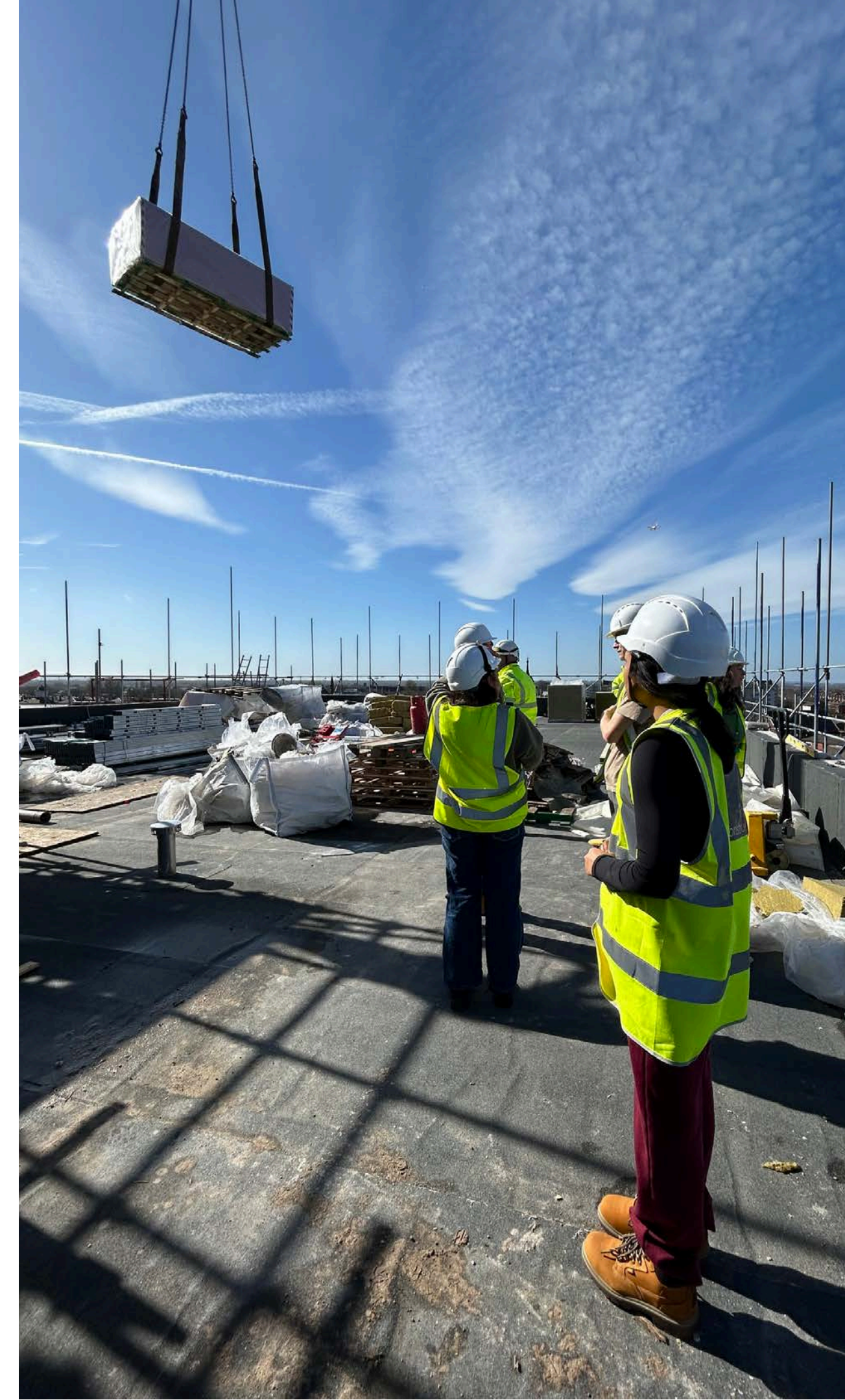
You will have substantial experience building and managing partnerships, bringing together a range of stakeholders to deliver shared goals and achieve positive outcomes for communities.
